

**Sand Lake Community Council
Resolution 2017-04**

SUBJECT: Water Body Located Near 61.144394° N, -149.991091°W; Westpark Subdivision Storm Water Drainage

WHEREAS, The Municipality of Anchorage offered three distinct options for addressing storm water drainage and aquifer contamination concerns near the Westpark Subdivision

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage requested feedback and option selection by area residents

BE IT RESOLVED, the Sand Lake Community Council selects the option that will permanently redirect storm water drainage that is in the vicinity of the Westpark Subdivision to drainage systems that flow under Dimond Boulevard and into the Cook Inlet; existing overflow to the water body located near 61.144394° N, -149.991091°W should be capped

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Sand Lake Community Council requests that storm water infrastructure be designed and constructed with sufficient capacity to carry runoff from current and future development in the area, including that of the Anchorage School District property along Westpark Drive

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Sand Lake Community Council requests that the Municipality of Anchorage expeditiously fund a tracer study to confirm the connectivity of the water body located near 61.144394° N, -149.991091°W and homeowner wells in the area

ADOPTED, this 28th day of August, 2017, Anchorage, Alaska by the Sand Lake Community Council.
