Campbell Creek Estuary Park Proposal

WHEREAS, The Sand Lake Community Council serves in an advisory capacity to the Administration and Departments of the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Parks in the Sand Lake area are important for our community, including the popular Jewel and Sand Lake Parks; and


WHEREAS, Conservation of Anchorage creeks and streams contributes to improved water quality and wildlife habitat; and

WHEREAS, Great Land Trust, a local non-profit, has successfully raised nearly half the funds to purchase a 60 acre parcel at the mouth of Campbell Creek which would be turned over to the Municipality as a City Park; and

WHEREAS, The property would have a conservation easement which would allow for public access and limited trail and educational displays but limit impacts to the wetlands and nearby uplands; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sand Lake Community Council supports Great Land Trust in its efforts to secure funding to purchase the 60 acre parcel and transfer it to the Municipality of Anchorage as a Park.
