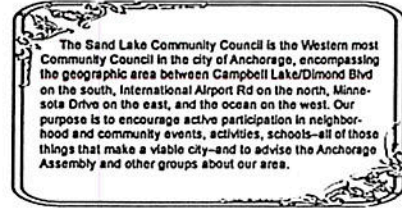

SUBJECT: Requesting speed humps be installed on several streets within the Sand Lake Community Council boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Sand Lake Community Council serves in an advisory capacity to the Administration and Departments of the Municipality of Anchorage;

WHEREAS, vehicular traffic on

- Blackberry Street near Strawberry Road,
- West 72nd Avenue near Arlene Street,
- Caravelle Drive near Silver Birch Drive and Crawford Street
- and Washburn Street, south of 88th Avenue

is unsafe and the speed of vehicles on these streets is often excessive. We believe that speed reduction through traffic calming measures, preferably speed humps, would greatly increase the safety of the above mentioned neighborhoods.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Sand Lake Community Council requests an engineering consultation and approval for speed humps to be installed at the above locations and supports the Municipal process of determining the viability and installation of requested measures.
