 - A. **Chester Creek Bridge.** In April, Peter Mjos presented a resolution for vote. The resolution (previously circulated) expresses support for a grant to build a bridge across Chester Creek below Maplewood, connecting trails on the south side of the creek to the north side, including Sitka Park. The resolution is withdrawn due to contingencies, but an update of information regarding the trail and Sitka Park will be presented (5 minutes by Pete and 15 minutes by Mr. Gibbs, Merrill Field Manager, as Merrill Field apparently owns a good deal of Sitka Park).
 - B. **Invasive Bird Cherry Tree Control Project Resolution** (revised). In March we heard from Tim Stallard of Alien Species Control, LLC, and Pamela Miller of Alaska Community Action on Toxics (ACAT), regarding a proposed resolution supporting the use of herbicide along the Chester Creek trail. The proposed resolution did not pass. Dave Evans proposes a modified form of this resolution for a vote.
 - C. **Liquor License pending before the Assembly.** A liquor license is pending for an Oaken Keg in the Midtown Mall (the old Sears Mall).
