A Resolution in Support of a Study by the Municipality of Anchorage to Determine Possible Solutions for Traffic Calming on Chirikof Street


WHEREAS, the Campbell Park Community Council, located in Midtown Anchorage, places a high standard on their quality of life. This quality of life is characterized by safe and quiet neighborhood streets; and


WHEREAS, individuals driving fast on our neighborhood streets adversely affects our quality of life. Driving fast in our neighborhood streets jeopardizes the safety of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Campbell Creek Community Council has long opposed individuals driving fast in our neighborhoods and are requesting the city traffic engineer conduct a traffic calming study.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Campbell Park Community Council, with 30 council members in attendance, and with a vote of 21 to 0, approves the request for a traffic calming study to be performed by the Municipality of Anchorage Traffic Engineer on Chirikof Street.
