Re: Proposed Sno Cross (Snowmobile) Race Site

Alaska Motor Musers Club, a non-profit organization, established in 1967, made up entirely of volunteers, dedicated to putting on safe, fun, family oriented snowmobile races around the State of Alaska is looking for a site to hold 6 events this winter in Anchorage.

Working with the Mayor's office, AMMC is looking for a site to replace the Third & Ingra St. location we've used the last 3+ years to hold our Sno Cross events, including the Fur Rondy race scheduled for February 24th. After many weeks of searching, the Mayor's office suggested a 9.33 acre site owned by MOA and managed by AWWU at the intersection of International Airport & Electron Rd (International East Track 4). A piece of commercial property, zoned I1 that offers separation from residential properties, good access, plenty of room for our track, pit & spectator parking and excellent drainage.

With the assistance of MOA Street Maintenance snow will be dumped on the site. Using front end loaders, bulldozers, etc... a track will be built out of snow. The track will be a semi-oval, approximately ¼ mile in length, 20-30 feet wide with a 50' safety corridor around it's entirety. A spectator area will also be built out of snow elevating the fans so they can better view the races.

AMMC will provide ample portable toilets, all necessary materials & personnel to insure safety standards, Medical staff will be present at all events as well as AFD will be notified (and on stand by) in case emergency transportation is needed.

AMMC (an ISR Sanctioned group) is fully insured for each event and will provide an insurance certificate for each event insuring AMMC, MOA and Greater Anchorage, Inc.

Here is our proposed schedule:

December 16th: Practice	December 30th: Practice
January 6th: Race	February 3rd: Race
February 24th: Fur Rondy Race	March 24th: Race

Prior to granting permission MOA AWWU has asked AMMC to run this proposal by the Community Councils involved insuring there is no opposition and would like a letter of approval stating so. I would like to attend your next CC meeting to present this proposal.
