When you sign in please denote with an “m” if you are a member, or a “g” if a guest. When voting, please follow the instructions using a show of “hands”. The RPCC host will mute anyone who exhibits improper or uncivil behavior. Interruptions are not allowed.

Roberts Rules of Order for voting: 1. No member may speak more than twice to the same motion. 2. No member may speak a second time until every member who wishes to speak has done so once. 3. Non members are not allowed to speak to a motion. An exception is a guest with knowledge of the motion’s issue. 4. Debate is to be focused on the “measure”, and not on the “member”, and be germane to the motion. Exceptions to the first three points are allowed by a 2/3 vote of the membership.
