**A RESOLUTION OF THE BIRCHWOOD COMMUNITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT
OF TRANSFERING \$4.5 MILLION TO DOT&PF FROM REMAINING
\$5.2MILLION OF THE EAGLE RIVER TRAFFIC MITIGATION GRANTS**

3 **WHEREAS**, In February 2011 the Eagle River Central Business District and
4 Residential Core Circulation Study (CBD Study) were conducted.

5
6 **WHEREAS**, A total of \$8.5 million in State Grants was provided to implement
7 priority projects from the CBD Study.

8
9 **WHEREAS**, The conclusion was made that the foundation to Eagle River traffic
10 connectivity is the design and construction of the Artillery Road Interchange.

11
12 **WHEREAS**, Consultants in 2021 and May 2023 stated there is good chance that
13 the Centerfield Connection project would be replaced with new concept of Artillery
14 Road Interchange.

16 **WHEREAS**, DOT&PF have put the cost of Phase 2 Artillery Road Interchange at
17 \$4.5 million.

18
19 **WHEREAS**, There is currently \$5.2 Million remaining in State Grant, administered
20 my the Municipality of Anchorage.

26 **THE BIRCHWOOD COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLVES:** To
27 request The Municipality of Anchorage and DOT&PF to transfer and
28 accept \$4.5 million from the remaining \$5.2 million of the Eagle River Traffic
29 Mitigation Grant, for full funding of the design of Artillery Road Interchange
30 before the June 2024 deadline.
