I am a recreational musher - small kennel 5-10 dogs. I have a garden large enough to support my organic choice of vegetables. I raise chickens for organic meat. I work at a very specialized agency in Anchorage that support special education services in rural and remote regions of the state.

Please do not develop a community plan that treats the Eagle River area, including Chugiak, and the Anchorage bowl in the same way. I have very good friends in Anchorage that choose to live there because that is the lifestyle they desire. I have as many friends that live outside of the Anchorage bowl because they detest the Anchorage restrictions to their lifestyle. I am one of those.
