Representatives from APD, ASD, Assembly and the Mayor's Office were not present to give reports.

There was a Highway to Highway (H2H) project presentation. John McPherson, with HDR, reported on the first round of public meetings in July. The focus was on the purpose and need for an environmental impact statement. Safety problems were addressed by project managers. Additional meetings have been scheduled. The next meeting will review public input. They will be looking at alternative options, examining new directions for transit and reviewing various routes from past consideration. This includes some solutions requiring the bypass of downtown and some possible underpasses. There were several other options discussed. A lengthy discussion followed the presentation.

Sharon Chamard, President of Fairview Community Council, requested support for a resolution to include land use impact in the purpose and need statement of the "Glenn Highway to Seward Highway" connection project environmental

impact statement. Jason Bergerson requested the resolution be sent to all councils for their consideration. Tom Freeman moved to adjourn.
