Pending motion for a resolution against any chokers within the RPCC district:

"RPCC does not support use of chokers for traffic calming within the Rogers Park Community Council District."

C. Stop sign removal and speed hump installation on 27th Avenue. Carl Ward is interested in alterations to the traffic calming along 27th Avenue in Rogers Park. He has obtained many signatures of neighbors on 27th Avenue on petitions to install speed humps. The petitions do not speak to stop signs, but Carl's goal is to both remove the stop signs and install the speed humps. To remove the stop signs he seeks a resolution from the community council, as follows:

"I move that the community council support the removal of the stop signs on East 27th Ave. at Sprucewood."
