  - A. **A Proposed Resolution Re: Anchorage Police Department Service.** This item is a follow-up to the November presentation by Assembly member Paul Honneman. At the request of the membership expressed at the November meeting, Bob Churchill has prepared a draft statement of concern regarding the depletion of police service in our community.
  - B. **A Proposed Resolution Re: Depletion of Funding For The Community Council System.** At the request of the Federation of Community Councils, Jim Wright has prepared a draft statement of concern regarding a threatened depletion of funding for the community council system. It was proposed that the FCC budget be cut from \$98,000 to \$30,000. If time permits we may have a general discussion regarding budget cuts, real and/or threatened, to public services including library, public transportation, fire protection, etc.
  - C. **Updating Member Contact Information.** With the threatened loss of support at the FCC level, it is more important than ever that we have good contact data for our members. We encourage you all to make sure that your name, address, phone and e-mail addresses are up to date. We will have a logbook available for that purpose at the December 13 meeting.
