

## **Notes from the August 17, 2011 FCC Meeting**

The August FCC meeting was held at Sugarspoon Bakery's conference room due to lack of conference space at the FCC office or building.

Vice-Chair Dick Tremaine chaired the meeting.

The meeting was well attended under the circumstances, about half a quorum.

The group discussed the FCC budget, that NUSA took much of our savings but did not leave us with additional debt, that there was still an obligation to pay for travel for Jason (NUSA National Board member) to Indianapolis to report on our conference and to print reports, and the fact that FCC expenses have been low over the summer but will now pick up in the fall.

Kathleen Plunkett gave a review of school district issues and acknowledged that something needs to be done to motivate the electorate to understand bonding issues and tradeoffs.

The delegates each took time to describe issues in their council area. Most councils have not met during the summer and are hoping for a quick start beginning in September.

The non-quorum meeting was over at 7 p.m.
