Bobbi Wells introduces Jim Winchester with Granite Construction, Jim reports that at Birchwood Airport there will be one less train moving gravel at this time. The berm construction has started this week, the reduction of trees and vegetation is allowing a little more from the shooting range to penetrate the surrounding area.

Road Board Report; Tony reports on possible abatement strategies to deal with ongoing complaints regarding speeding traffic to be evaluated by the road board; including speed bumps or humps that have been requested by concerned residents. A stormwater drainage study will begin, putting video cameras through the storm drains to check the condition of the existing culverts and drainpipes.

Parks and Rec. Report; Bobbi reports, bids for the McDonald Center expansion have come in. She also reports that the Beach Lake ski trail will expand lighting and upgrade to LED bulbs. Laura Rhinehold with South Fork Community Council is working on ski trails near Eagle River High School and is looking for support for an over pass ski trail.

Consortium Report; Bobbi reports, There will be a public Town Hall meeting on July 28 at the Lions at 6 pm. Bobbi encourages council members to provide input on our separate Chapter of land use regulations at this meeting prior to giving public testimony before the P&Z Commissioners and the Assembly.
