

**RESOLUTION
OF THE
SPENARD COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

"A resolution requesting The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority postpone any action toward acquisition of the Long House."

Whereas, the Anchorage Municipal Charter Article VIII grants unto a duly recognized Community Council the basic right of self determination, and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council being a duly organized community council under section 2.40.010 of the Anchorage Municipal Code, and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council was formed in 1975 and has met regularly, and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council has been consistently one of the most active community councils, and


Whereas, the Spenard Community Council believes in community and good neighbors, and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council believes that, although Anchorage Community Mental Health Services (ACMHS) should work with the SCC for the betterment of the entire community, ACMHS has to date demonstrated an indifference to the desires and well being of the Spenard community, and

Whereas, as an Alaska State Corporation, The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority (The Trust), should work with, rather than around communities and their representative bodies, and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council attempted, at the invitation of Anchorage Assembly Chair Ernie Hall and Anchorage Ombudsman Darrel Hess, to enter into a dialogue with ACMHS and The Trust, no meetings have been held since December 11, 2012 although at that time SCC requested at least two subsequent meeting and a tour of ACMHS facilities before The Trust's Board meets on January 30th and 31st,

Be It Therefore Resolved, that the Spenard Community Council petitions The Trust to delay any action toward the acquisition of the Long House until such time that the dialogue and meetings initiated by Misters Hall and Hess to foster mutual understanding, respect and community can resume and until the SCC's questions have been answered and concerns addressed, with at least one public hearing held in Spenard to be included in this process.
