Supporting the construction of a Northeast Anchorage Bike Skills Park and Pump Track and encouraging the State Legislature to fully fund the project.

WHERE AS, the Mountain View Community Council fully supports providing safe, healthy activities for youth and their families in our community; and

WHERE AS, Mountain View would benefit from additional structured outdoor activities for youth and adults; and

WHERE AS, Davis Park is an excellent community space in Mountain View that could host a Bike Park; and

WHERE AS, the residents of Mountain View are committed to continuing to increasing quality of life and making it the best possible place to live and raise a family; and

WHERE AS, the residents of Mountain View are enthusiastic to partner with City of Anchorage Parks and Recreation, non-profits, and the Youth Employment in Parks, to build and maintain recreational opportunities in Mountain View for our residents; and


WHERE AS, this project would be the first pump track in Anchorage and would serve as a destination facility for cyclists Anchorage-wide, increasing economic activity in the neighborhood; and

WHERE AS, the Municipal Budget request to the State legislature contains a request for \$61,000 for sight location, design and construction of a Bike Park and Pump Track using the Youth Employment in Parks Northeast Anchorage.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mountain View Community Council fully supports the Northeast Anchorage Bike Skills Park and Pump Track and encourages the State Legislature to fund it as a Parks and Recreation budget request.
