### Resolution 2013-~~02~~ of the Mountain View Community Council

At the September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2013 regular full meeting of the Mountain View Community Council, the Council voted unanimously in favor of a verbal proposed resolution supporting the Alaska Native Cultural Charter School's (ANCCS) request to have a school zone with flashing speed control signs installed in front of the school grounds on Bragaw street, between the intersections with 6<sup>th</sup> avenue and the Glenn Highway

Residents shared comments expressing strong support for the installation of these safety measures. The meeting was attended by more than 40 people, though not everyone was a member of the council. The number of residents who were signed in at the meeting was 16. While the area in question is not within the Mountain View Community Council boundaries, it would adjoin the council's southern boundary, which is the Glenn Highway, and would impact the many Mountain View residents traveling in and out of Mountain View via Bragaw.
