RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE DAVIS PARK MASTER PLAN (2015)

- WHEREAS, The Mountain View Community Council is an independent non-profit, voluntary, self-governing association composed of residents 16 years of age or older, non-resident property owners, business owners, and non-profit organizations from the Mountain View neighborhood, and is recognized by the Anchorage Municipal Charter and Municipal Code; and
- WHEREAS, The purpose of the community councils is to provide a direct and ongoing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs; and
- WHEREAS, The Davis Park Master Plan is identified as one of the Mountain View Community Council's top five priorities as described in the Mountain View Targeted Neighborhood Plan, which was recently submitted to the Municipality for review and adoption; and
- WHEREAS, The Davis Park Master Plan provides a 20 Year vision for the management and development of Davis Park; and
- WHEREAS, The planning and public involvement process for the Davis Park Master Plan was guided by an advisory group and included two public open house events; and
- WHEREAS, The recommendations identified in the Master Plan include upgraded athletic fields, new community gardens, a 9-hole disc golf course, upgraded basketball courts, a skate park, a bike park, a boulder climbing area, upgraded trails and neighborhood connections, an expanded parking lot, and other amenities to improve park users experience; and
- WHEREAS, The future development of Davis Park as identified in this plan will provide positive and active recreational activities for all members of the Mountain View neighborhood; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED: The Mountain View Community Council supports the Davis Park Master Plan, as presented.
