### GOVERNMENT HILL COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2016-02

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GOVERNMENT HILL PARKS COMMITTEE REVIEW FOR THE 2016 PARKS MAINTENANCE WORK PLAN

WHEREAS, the Government Hill Community Council wishes to co-operate with the Municipality of Anchorage in an effort to maintain the neighborhood parks at their optimum appearance and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Government Hill Parks Committee has identified work that is needed in the Government Hill parks for 2016; and

WHEREAS, the community of Government Hill, with the help of the Municipality of Anchorage, resolves to accomplish the following in the Government Hill parks before the first snow falls in 2016 (\*starred items are requesting labor or administrative help from the Municipality).

#### ALDERWOOD PARK

- \*Remove graffiti from the train and re-paint it
- \*Repair the fence separating Alderwood Park from the alley
- \*Conduct a "clean-and-green" in the vacant lot immediately to the west of the park, so it can be upgraded to park status
- \*Construct a fence along the south side of the park so that youngsters playing in the park will not be in danger of going over the bluff

#### AL MILLER PARK

Clear brush in park so it is not thick enough to be dangerous

\*Remove trash/debris from park borders along the alley

#### **BROWN'S POINT PARK**

\*Selectively remove poplars/cottonwoods along the south border of the park in order to create a better view of downtown

#### HARVARD PARK

\*Transplant and maintain flowers in the flowerbeds

#### RICHARDSON PARK

\*Install 5 ornamental or edible shrubs (alpine currants, raspberries, etc.)

#### SUNSET PARK

- \*Provide "doggie-waste" bags for those who walk their dogs in the park
- \*Update the playground equipment and swings

#### SUZAN NIGHTINGALE MCKAY PARK

Transplant and maintain flowers in the flowerbed

- \*Maintain shrub beds
- \*Replace park signs at both entrances
- \*Trim hedges below last year's trim lines
- \*Remove trees that are blocking the view of Denali from the Sydney Lawrence Memorial
- \*Conduct a "clean-and-green" to finish the work that was begun last year behind the hedge

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Government Hill Community Council to approve the Government Hill Parks Committee 2016 parks maintenance work plan.
