Resolution 2017-12

Addition of Midtown Community Council area to the  
North Star Community Council

Whereas, the Midtown Community Council (MTCC) was formed in February 2004 by the passage of AO-2004-27; and

Whereas, the section north of West 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Fireweed Lane was taken from North Star Community Council (NSCC);

Whereas, the intent of creating the council was to develop an organization to mainly represent the businesses in mid-town to advocate for issues affecting them; and

Whereas, participation in the council never grew to include enough businesses, residents and property owners to have a viable organization, with meetings usually having between 4 and 6 members; and

Whereas, two successful joint meetings with North Star Community Council (NSCC) were held in 2014 when agenda items were issues that affected both councils; and

Whereas, most of the issues that concern MTCC are also shared by North Star Community Council (SCC);

Whereas, the president of NSCC and the Manager of the FCC attended the October 12, 2016 meeting of MTCC where this merger was discussed; and

Whereas, the Spenard Community Council and the Taku Campbell Community Council attended the November 9, 2016 MTCC meeting to consider if they would like to annex a southern part of MTCC's area; and

Whereas, the North Star Community Council has subsequently discussed inclusion of the northern part of MTCC; and

Now therefore be it resolved, that the North Star Community Council (NSCC) requests the Anchorage Planning and Zoning Commission and the Anchorage Assembly to approve a merger with the North Star Community Council for the area north of 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

Be it further resolved, that the MidTown Community Council requests the Anchorage Planning and Zoning Commission and the Anchorage Assembly to approve a merger with the Spenard Community Council for the area south of 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

Be it further resolved that the name of the council shall cease to exist.
