A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT AND NON-OBJECTION OF A SPECIAL LAND USE PERMIT FOR THE ALASKA CARES FACILITY ON A STREET AND 48TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Spenard Community Council (the Council) supports Alaska CARES, a Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) and member of the National Children's Alliance that provides comprehensive, child-centered programs in a facility that empowers law enforcement, child protection professionals, prosecutors, mental health professionals, victim advocates, and the medical community to work together to evaluate child abuse cases.


WHEREAS, 6,597 allegations of child maltreatment were reported within the Municipality of Anchorage between March 2016 and February 2017 by means of Protective Service Reports to the Alaska Office of Children's Services¹.

WHEREAS, Alaska CARES provides needed support to children and families in the Anchorage area by connecting them to valuable services that help the healing process begin.

WHEREAS, by a vote of 19 yea, and 0 nay, the Council votes to support this Resolution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Spenard Community Council does hereby support for Alaska CARES to receive a special land use permit for the proposed facility on A street and 48th Avenue.
