AIRPORT SOUND INSULATION PROGRAM

ANC airport is implementing a "Quieter Home Program" to reduce impacts of aircraft noise on surrounding neighborhoods. The first step in the implementation process involves 30 homes in the most noise impacted areas. Homes that are located in the 65Db DNL contour and constructed before 1998 will be eligible for the program. The Quieter Home Program will be implemented in phases that will occur over several years. We thank all of our neighbors in Lupes neighborhood for helping the fire A.W.A.R.E. plan work and I want to thank all my neighbors..You are all AWESOME....
