Project Overview

The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) Project Management and Engineering Department (PM&E) is investigating a project to replace the existing deteriorated storm drain south of St. Gotthard Ave and east of the New Seward Highway. Improvements may include new storm drain pipe and manhole support.

PM&E's engineering design consultant, PTS Inc., is working on a Design Study Report (DSR) to analyze design alternatives. Findings will be presented to residents, stakeholders and property owners and feedback will be solicited as part of the Public Involvement Plan.
