- 1. Call to Order at 7:05pm by **Scott Myers**, President, at Eagle River High School. A total of 9 participants with several guest speakers (see below). Introductions made.
- 2. Agenda approved without additions or amendments.
- 3. Minutes approval for October postponed to December's meeting.
- 4. Guest Speakers:
 - a. Nancy Clark, Eagle River Library shared upcoming events and that the digital magazines are now available in the library database digitally.
 - b. Cliff Cook, Community Patrol shared that the Community Patrol worked 19 hours and covered 176 miles. Encourages people to continue to be vigilant and lock and close their garage doors at night. Gas theft is becoming more common. If you see a crime, report it to APD so they know how many officers to assign to the CER area.
 - c. Amy Demboski, MOA Manager's Office will be sending an email about Eaglexit to the CER Advisory Board. The newly hired Parks and Rec Deputy Director will be housed in Eagle River. The State of Alaska reimbursed more than expected (\$23 million) of ambulance transfers so the extra money will be used on fire and police vehicles. The MOA is also experiencing staff shortages, lack of applicants.
