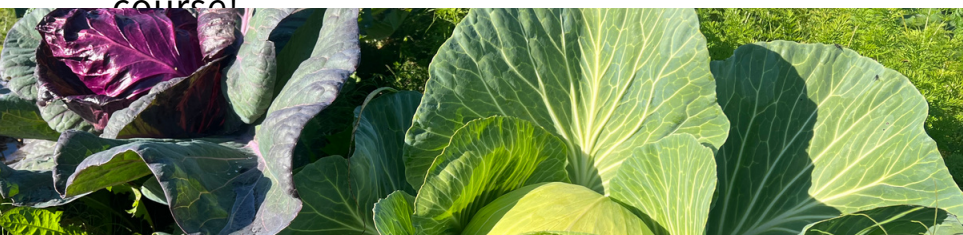


## Fairview Community Gardens We need your voice

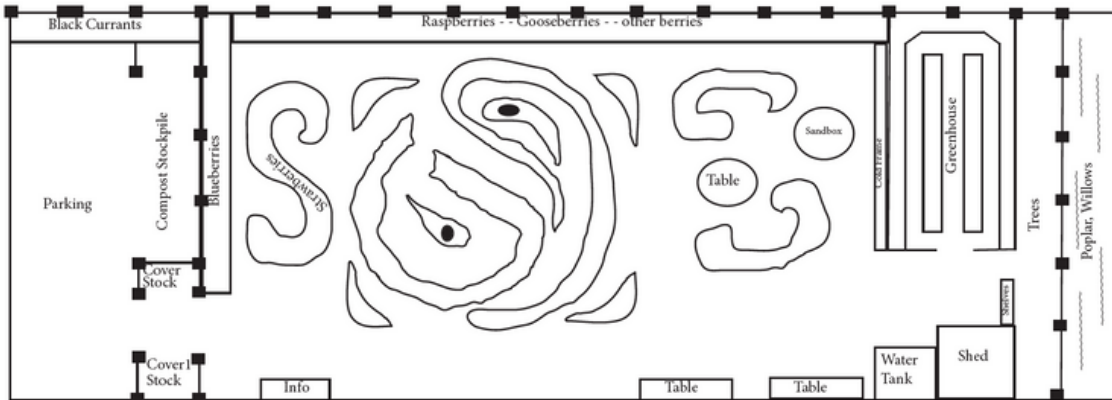

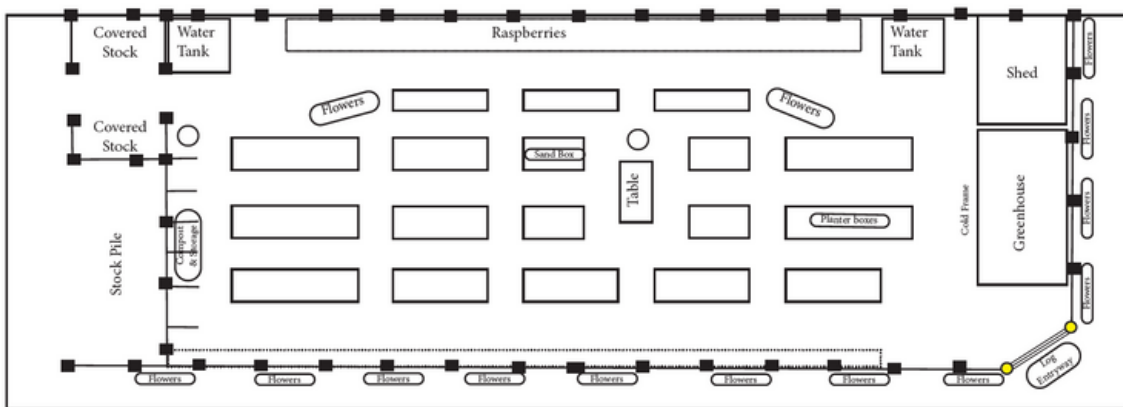
## Lot 1: 1326 Ingra Street
