

South Addition Draft Resolution 2025-001

Whereas, the Anchorage School District as of 09/26/2024 has placed Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) on the Inlet View temporary play area to the east and northeast of the school building; and Whereas, RAP may contain up to 7% of petroleum asphalt chips and dust. Petroleum asphalt is the residual product associated with crude oil distillation. RAP has many health concerns and precautions for those that work with it.

The following are the Hazards:

H350 - May cause cancer.

H372 - Causes damage to organs through prolonged and repeated exposure.

The following are the precautions:

P201 - Obtain special instructions before use.

P202 - Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

P260 - Do not breathe dust or vapors.

P264 - Wash hands, forearms, and other exposed areas thoroughly after handling.

P270 - Do not eat, drink, or smoke when using this product.

P280 - Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, and eye protection.

P308+P313 - If exposed or concerned: Get medical advice/attention.

P314 - Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.

P405 - Store locked up. P501 - Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local, regional, national and international regulations.
