## NORTHWOOD DRIVE/ HARDING DRIVE UPDATE

Steve Noble of Dowl Engineers will update the Council on the status of two long standing (and delayed) road projects; 1)Northwood Drive, between Spenard Road and International Airport Road and 2)Harding Drive/Van Buren Street Extension, near the Spenard Rec Center.

#### PLATTING UPDATE

In March 2004, the Platting Authority granted Richard Vrlaku's application to vacate the west one-half of the Garfield Street right of way abutting the east boundary of Lot 6, Block H, Birchwood Park Subdivision, located south of W.47th Ave and west of Garfield Street, subject to the recording of a final plat within 18 months. A plat has not been recorded and Vrlaku has sought an 18 month time extension. A hearing before the Platting Authority is scheduled for November 2, 2005 and comments are due October 14, 2005.

## AIRPORT UPDATE

Members of the planning division at Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport will update the Council on matters discussed at the September meeting, including the Echo Parking Phase II project and the cleanup of vegetation at Lake Hood. Additionally, the Airport has released to the Council all written comments to the draft proposed alternatives for the Lake Hood Master Plan and they will be available at the October meeting.

### LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWALS

A list of the liquor licenses up for renewal will be available at the October meeting and the Council will discuss whether action needs to be taken with regard to any Spenard licenses.
