It was recently announced that Karluk Manor is considering relocating to Mountain View.

Karluk Manor is a “housing first” facility where chronic inebriates can obtain permanent housing as a first step towards community integration and self-sufficiency.

The council is concerned about the project but has not taken a position in support of or in opposition to the project. We have objected to the lack of community involvement and have asked that we be part of negotiations.
