To summarize, here are the basic steps....

1. Someone in the community makes a request for traffic calming for a street/neighborhood
 2. The Community Council issues a "resolution in support of traffic calming" for said street
 3. We perform a traffic study (current estimated timeline is the beginning of next summer)
 4. The street is found to qualify for traffic calming assistance on our end if the 85th percentile speed of traffic is found to be greater than or equal to 5mph over the posted speed limit
 5. The Community Council prioritizes this project with respect to other traffic calming projects and other Capital Improvement Projects in their area
 6. If the project is high enough priority and funds are available, we propose a solution
