#### AIRPORT REPORT

### TAP ROOT LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER

TR2, Inc's application for a transfer of the Tap Root beverage dispensary license from Tap Root Alaskan, Inc., which was discussed at the February meeting, was approved by the Assembly at their meeting on February 17, 2015. The matter will be further discussed at the March meeting.

### PEOPLE MOVER PROPOSED CHANGES

The People Mover bus service is proposing to dramatically alter service on Route 36, eliminating approximately 20 stops on Minnesota Drive, Tudor Road, Taft Street, 48th Avenue, and Northwood Drive. If the change goes through, there will no longer any bus service to the Spenard Recreation Center or to Northwood Elementary. The Council adopted a resolution rejecting the proposed changes at its February meeting; however, the changes were subsequently approved by the Public Transit Advisory Board at their February 12th meeting, despite overwhelming public testimony against the changes. The matter will be discussed at the March meeting.

### RECENT ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS

The annual election of officers, required by the bylaws, occurred at the February meeting. As the current chair was term limited out, Phil Isley was elected as the new chair. Irene Persson was elected as secretary. The other officers, Jason Bergerson (vice chair) and Allen Thornhill (treasurer) were reelected.

businessman (owner of the Second Chance) and Council member Tom Bichsel, 88, died peacefully at home on February 16, 2015. He will be greatly missed.
