Meeting Minutes from December 16, 2015**

Meeting called to order, without a quorum, at 7:02 p.m.

**Guest Presentations**

- State Senator: No representative present
- State Representative: Robert Ervine, Legislative Aide to Representative Craig Johnson present. Per a request, Robert explained Representative Johnson's responsibilities as the Rules Chairman. Robert said Rep. Johnson is in the preliminary phase of reviewing Governor Walker's proposed budget, and is willing and open to ideas from constituents. Those ideas can be emailed to Robert at robert.ervine@akleg.gov or Rep. Johnson at representative.craig.johnson@akleg.gov. Rep. Johnson's goal is to reduce the budget without hurting the economy.
- Local Assembly: No representative present
- Anchorage School District Board: ASD Board Clerk Tam Agosti-Gisler shared a short PowerPoint presentation showing the 2016 budgetary needs and the revenue outlook for the school district. She stated layoffs are inevitable this year. Tam explained what the \$49.3 million bond will be used for if approved by Anchorage residents in April. The search for a new Superintendent is ongoing. On a positive note, she shared graduation rates are at an all-time high of 80.2%.
