## **A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH ADDITION COMMUNITY COUNCIL NOMINATING THE NEIGHBORHOODS' TOP SIX CHOICES FOR CIP PROJECTS FOR 2016-2017 IN THE SOUTH ADDITION COMMUNITY COUNCIL AREA**

WHEREAS, the South Addition Community Council ("SACC") has each year reviewed the CIP Projects proposed for development by the Municipality of Anchorage and the State of Alaska and polled its members as to their own choices and other preferred projects; and

WHEREAS, SACC has a vested interest in ensuring public spaces represent the character of its neighborhood and are safe, well-maintained places;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

SACC hereby supports and requests that whenever the Municipality of Anchorage make the following the top six projects for the SACC area in the order of priority listed below:

1. Sidewalk rehabilitation;
2. An access point near 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the Coastal Trail;
3. Improvements and maintenance at Delaney Park Strip;
4. Hockey rink rehabilitation at Delaney park Strip;
5. Pedestrian safety improvements on "A" Street between 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 10<sup>th</sup> Ave;
6. Pedestrian safety improvements on "C" Street between 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 10<sup>th</sup> Ave.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the South Addition Community Council this 19th day of May, 2016 by a vote of 4 in favor; 0 opposed; and 0 abstentions.
